SECTION - 3: Livestock Protégé

Rules:

A protégé book will be provided to each child at registration and must be completed and turned in on the Saturday prior to Fair.

Sheep:	9 - 19 years of age as of January 1 (Junior 9-12, Senior 13-19)
Swine:	9 - 19 years of age as of January 1 (Junior 9-12, Senior 13-19)
Rabbit:	9 - 19 years of age as of January 1 (Junior 9-12, Senior 13-19)
Poultry:	9 - 19 years of age as of January 1 (Junior 9-12, Senior 13-19)
Cavy:	9 - 19 years of age as of January 1 (Junior 9-12, Senior 13-19)
4. Protégé exhibitors are not allowed to show in the regular division in which they are Protégés.

Rules:

1. This program is open to registered 4-H youth ages 5-8 years of age as of January 1st, of the current year, who have turned in their paper work and fees on time.
2. Registration for this program is the first Tuesday in the month of May at 6:00 p.m. If you are unable to attend the registration workshop, you must notify the 4-H Livestock Education Committee Chairperson. More information regarding registration may be obtained from Anita Sampson. A Cloverbud book will be provided to each child at registration and must be completed and turned in on the Saturday prior to Fair.
3. Age groups are as follows:
 - Beef: 5-8 years of age as of January 1 (Junior 5-6, Senior 7-8)
 - Dairy: 5-8 years of age as of January 1 (Junior 5-6, Senior 7-8)
 - Goat: 5-8 years of age as of January 1 (Junior 5-6, Senior 7-8)
 - Sheep: 5-8 years of age as of January 1 (Junior 5-6, Senior 7-8)
 - Swine: 5-8 years of age as of January 1 (Junior 5-6, Senior 7-8)
 - Rabbit: 5-8 years of age as of January 1 (Junior 5-6, Senior 7-8)
 - Poultry: 5-8 years of age as of January 1 (Junior 5-6, Senior 7-8)
 - Cavy: 5-8 years of age as of January 1 (Junior 5-6, Senior 7-8)
4. Cloverbuds may own their own animals or use their teacher's. Cloverbuds are not allowed to show in regular division.
5. Each teacher and Cloverbud will receive an award for participation in the program.
6. Five and Six (5-6) year olds may be involved with animals on a halter or lead. They must be directly assisted one-on-one by a youth teacher, and a parent, guardian, or adult volunteer who is on the ground holding the animal's halter or lead to maximize safety.
