GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

Show time: Saturday, August 12, 2017 at 10:00 a.m.

Test Dates: Saturday, July 29, 2017 at 1:00 p.m. & Friday, August 11, 2017 at 10:00 a.m.

Rules:

1. Open to registered 4-H youth who have turned in all their fees and all their paperwork by July 15, 2017.
2. Any youth unable to attend the Master Stockman test on July 29, 2017, or August 11, 2017, must notify the Education Committee Chairperson of any extenuating circumstances prior to the test date.
3. Live animal Showmanship will consist of animals from the following Livestock and Small Animal Divisions: Beef Cattle, Dairy Cattle, Goats, Swine, Sheep, Rabbits, and Poultry. All participants are required to show live animals from these divisions.
4. To qualify for Master Stockman competition, the participant must place 1st or 2nd in showmanship class in the following divisions: Beef Cattle, Dairy Cattle, Goats, Swine, Sheep, Rabbits, Cavy, and Poultry.
5. If a 4-H member places 1st or 2nd in Showmanship in two or more divisions, then the member will choose only one division under which to enter. The 3rd place exhibitor in that class will then be allowed to compete in that division.
6. Round Robin Showmanship Contest will be scored (per specie) on:
 - A. Showmanship - 20
 - B. Knowledge - 10
 - C. Personal Appearance of Exhibitor - 5
7. Questions will encompass all aspects of breeding, showing, market, veterinary science, and animal husbandry. Questions for this contest are formulated from information obtained from *Michigan State University Extension Publications. Livestock Resource Manual* may be obtained from the 4-H Livestock Developmental Committee.
8. All participants must be in show attire. See dress code and superintendent requirements.
9. Master Stockman winners from previous year(s) will be allowed to compete, providing they meet the requirements as stated in Rule 2 and Rule 4 above.
10. Exhibitors that take a 1st place in their showmanship class will be awarded the maximum points allowed for that specie in the Round Robin showing portion of test. Exhibitors who have placed 1st in showmanship in multiple classes **MUST** designate what specie they wish to take the points.
